“ I am Gene Dillard, stepson of Charles. I was 5 when he came into my life and he and my mom divorced age 13. He taught me baseball and watched me play little league. He was an athlete in high school, playing baseball. At age 45, I watch him hit a ball that would easily have been a home run in Tiger Stadium. We lived in local area of Detroit. After divorce, later in life at 24, I was able to spend time fishing and visiting he and his wife, Verna. They lived in Oscoda for a number of years before moving to Vero Beach Fl. for a while. Later, he moved back to his home state and town of Mayfield, which I had visited with him when about 10 years of age. He was a pleasant and nice person to be around. He struggled as most in life finding and doing many jobs. I really never knew him as a carpenter. He worked as mechanic and worked for awhile at an auto plant. It was terrible and hard work lasting briefly. He had to polish chrome bumpers on cars, having to lift the bumper to polish on a wheel. He also took us back to Texas where he had met my mom while serving in the air force in early 50s. He had a long life, I hope he did not suffer and his last days were enjoyed. I am sorry I never visited him again or kept in touch. Gene Dillard (73), his other two step sons have passed, Archie Dillard (62) and Robert J Dillard (77). Also his ex wife (my mom) passed on in 2001. No one is left to read, but I had to put something to add to his remembrance, sorry I did not know of his passing, I would have loved to have sent some flowers. 12/11/21
